Call to action-

2. **Look up your situation in a book and do what the book tells you.** Learn, become skilled, become one of those teachers you see in schools that have control and discipline over their students, if your whole school is a disaster then become like a teacher we have seen in movies, or in other people’s schools or like the teachers you remember having growing up.
3. **The right time to do this with students is when they are in the first day of class** right after you tell them your name. If that time has passed already, then the right time to start is now.

What I can help you with is taking all that information these books teach people and give you a **big picture** understanding so you can get your head around the information.
